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Course abstract

The course is envisaged for the students of Bachelor study program “Philology”. The course includes the topics concerning the classification of the parts of speech, their grammatical categories, declination types, relations between morphology and syntax.

Results

Trained in the course students are able to

- respond to direct questions or requests for information and are capable of asking a variety of questions when necessary to obtain simple information;
- meet a number of practical writing needs: they can write short, simple communications, compositions, and requests for information in loosely connected texts about personal preferences, daily routines, common events, and other personal topics;
- understand with often accuracy highly familiar and predictable topics;
- read and get some meaning from short connected texts featuring description and narration, dealing with familiar topics;
- gain an understanding of Russian morphological system;
- identify parts of speech;
- are oriented in semantics and syntactical functions of parts of speech.

12. Gender category of numerals. Number category of numerals. Numeral declination category. Declination of numerals.
13. Role of different categories of pronouns, morphological character, changes in word-formation, syntactic functions.

Imperfectivation and perfectivation. Pairs of verbs by type. Uniform, double-form verbs. The verbs of motion.

Tense category. Imperfective verb forms of the present tense and their meanings. Imperfective verb forms of the past and future tenses and their meanings. Perfective verb forms of the past and future tenses and their meanings.

Meanings of personal form. Impersonal verbs. Verb conjugation.
