Course Plan

Course structure: lectures – 8 acad. hours., seminars – 8 acad. hours.

Lecture topics:

1. Russian culture and literature in the 1980-1990s: directions, trends, themes.
2. Historical genre in literature. Peculiarities of J. Davidov's, V. Pjecuh's, J. Bujda's writing.
3. Women's prose: L. Petruševskaya's, T. Tolstaya's, M. Paley's artistic phenomenon.
4. Modern Russian poetry.

Seminar topics:

1. Ven. Jerofejev's oeuvre. "Moscow - Petushki". Venechka's image.
2. V. Makagin's oeuvre. "Underground, or A Hero of Our Time."
3. T. Tolstaya's novel "Kis": the artistic world, the stylistic characteristics, signs of postmodern literature
4. Recent trends in contemporary Russian literature (by student choice).

Students' individual work (reports):

Reading literary works (the list is updated according to the latest trends in literature)

Womens prose: the concept, the circle of authors. Presentation of selected literary works of modern Russian literature.

Learning Outcomes

Having acquired the study course, students:

- demonstrate their understanding of the logic of Russian literature and culture of the since the 1990s;
- are able to independently identify, analyze and evaluate causes and results of the changes in Russian cultural paradigm since the 1990s;
- explain the artistic picture of the world depicted in the Russian artistic fiction since the 1990s; - independently develop their professional competence, identifying the current trends of the modern Russian literature and culture research.
